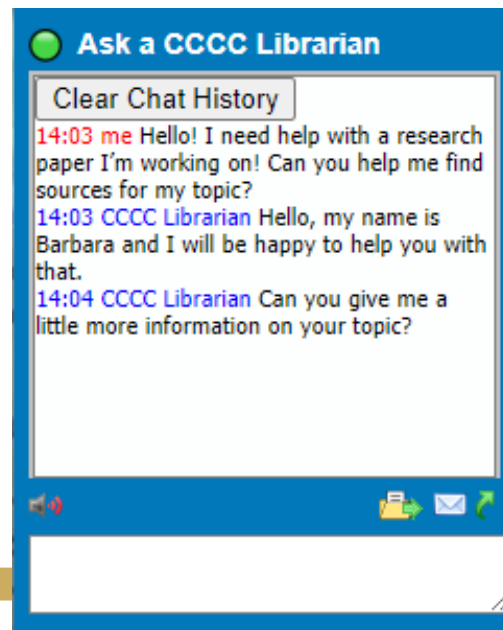

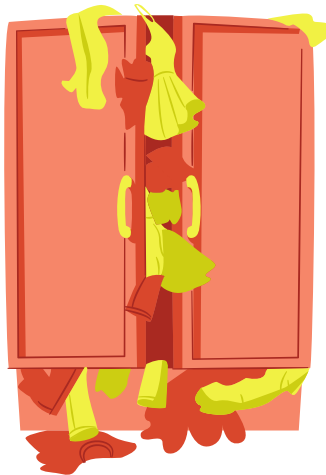
Notice on Textbook Pickups

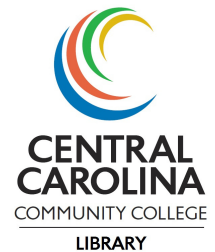
