



## NURSING BRIDGE LIMITED ENROLLMENT ADMISSIONS PROCESS

## Submit CCCC Admissions Application

Submit ALL

• Submitted a <u>CCCC Admissions Application</u> within the last 12 months or be currently enrolled.

## Submit ALL past transcripts

- High School or GED
- All Past Colleges, even if no degree or credential was attained.
- Students must be ready to take ENG-111 and MAT-110 without a co-requisite course.
- Students can meet this requirement by having completed past ENG and MAT courses, High School GPA (within the past 10 years) of 2.8 or higher, or test scores.
- Students are required to complete the Health Science Information Session.
- Complete the ATI TEAS Exam within the past three years. Minimum scores: Reading - 70, Composite - 65
- Complete the <u>ATI PN Predictor</u> after 6 months of LPN Completion. Minimum scores: **Individual Score - 80**
- Learn about scheduling and paying for the exams.
- The following courses are *required to be completed with a grade of "B"* or better prior to applying: BIO-168 and BIO-169.
- The following courses are *required to be completed with a grade* of "C" or better prior to applying: ENG-111, PSY-150, PSY-241, SOC-210, ENG-112, Humanities Elective, & ACA-122.
- Students must have a GPA of **2.8** or higher. This is calculated based on the general education courses for the program.
- Students can apply if they have a **2.5-2.8** GPA but will be placed on an alternate list. Alternates will be considered if there are not enough applicants to fill seats.
- Students are required to be Licensed Practical Nurses and be listed on the **NC Board of Nursing Verification website**.

## **OTHER REQUIREMENTS**

Eligibility to Apply	<ul> <li>Once the requirements have been met, students can submit a Limited Enrollment Application which is linked from the Success Hub (linked in your <u>CCCC</u> <u>Portal</u>).</li> <li>Students are reviewed on a rolling basis and entered based on date of application.</li> </ul>
Statement of Good Standing	<ul> <li>If students were ever dismissed or withdrawn from a previous Health Science Program, they must submit a <u>Statement of Good Standing</u>.</li> </ul>
Complete TOEFL Exam	<ul> <li><u>TOEFL</u> scores are required for any naturalized or non-US citizen with English as the second language.</li> <li>Students must submit test scores (within 5 years):         <ul> <li>TOEFL iBT Total Score - 80 or higher</li> <li>TOEFL Essential Overall Band Score: 8 or higher</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Submit Additional Records (If Accepted)	<ul> <li>Submit required immunization records <ul> <li>Required: MMR, TDAP, Varicella, TB Skin Test, Flu</li> </ul> </li> <li>Complete required drug testing <ul> <li>Complete background check</li> </ul> </li> <li>Submit proof of CPR or Complete with Program <ul> <li>American Heart Association - BLS Provider</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Meeting with Department Chair (If Accepted)	<ul> <li>Students are required to meet with the Department Chair for the program prior to the program start date.</li> </ul>
Attend Program Orientation <i>(If Accepted)</i>	<ul> <li>Each student will be required to attend a program orientation. This usually occurs during the summer before courses start. This will provide a good overview of program requirements and assist students in preparing to start the program.</li> </ul>
